

Here are a few walks that you might care to try. All start and finish in the car park.

Maybe if you are feeling adventurous you might combine several to get a better view of the park.

Please note that some of the walks have a few steeper gradients & distances are approximate.



AROUND THE GREAT LAKE

A longer route around the spectacular 60-acre Great Lake. There are some stunning views to be found with a pleasant walk through the trees on the last leg back to the car park. This route is just over 1 and a half miles and includes a steeper gradient downwards at the end.



TO BRICKYARD LAKE AND BACK

A lovely route taking you to the picturesque Brickyard Lake. The smaller of our 2 lakes is sheltered on its south side by steep cliffs that are designated a Site of Special Scientific Interest. At just over half a mile, you will stroll back to the car park through a delightful woodland walk.



AROUND BRICKYARD LAKE

A longer route around the charming Brickyard Lake, this route takes you around the south side, above the lake. Just over a mile long, there are some steep gradients as you descend from the cliff top down through the trees.



A SHORT WOODLAND STROLL

A sort half mile stroll through the woods in an area many remember as the "Trim Trail". A route to try if you are short on time or maybe combine with another to make a longer route.
